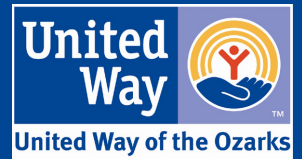

\$500-\$999: Emerging Community Owner

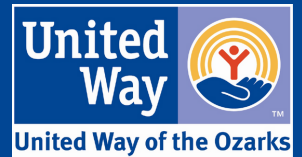
TOP 10 EMPLOYEE CAMPAIGN MANAGERS
